Marina Safety

Just a reminder on a few tips to keep everyone safe around the Marina

- 10kmh speed restriction
- Always watch out for pedestrians and please give way
- Careful around the ramps they can become slippery
- Report any Hazards to the Marina Manager



Petrol Pumps

On the odd occasion we can have long lines at the pumps, such as on the 17th of February when we had 75 Jet ski's visits on their annual circumnavigation. The pumps are available for all users on the lake, and we ask that everyone waits their turn and plans in the busier times to avoid congestion. In future we will try and anticipate these events to better ease overall congestion in the Marina.



Maintenance

As we start heading into the cooler months and the summer jobs fall away, we can focus on other jobs that need completing around the Marina, for the next few months our focus will be

- Planting out vacant areas in the gardens
- Replacing deteriorated boards on walkways and docks
- Water blasting and spraying Piers three, five and seven
- Reducing Vegetation on the groynes

If there are any other items that need installing or fixing on your berths, please contact the Marina Manager to organise repair, we have access to fenders, dock wheels, rope hooks and most other items upon request.

The Lighting upgrade to LED was completed late in 2023 and more recently an overall health check done on dock bulbs and RCD's.

New catchment nets have been installed in the washdown areas and are proving to provide much better drainage, mountain bikers are actively discouraged from using these drains, these are for boats only.

On Site Contractors

If you are getting an outside contractor to come and work on your boat in the Marina, please ensure that they know to check in with the Marina Manager, so they are informed of any potential Health & Safety risks and sign the onsite register.
