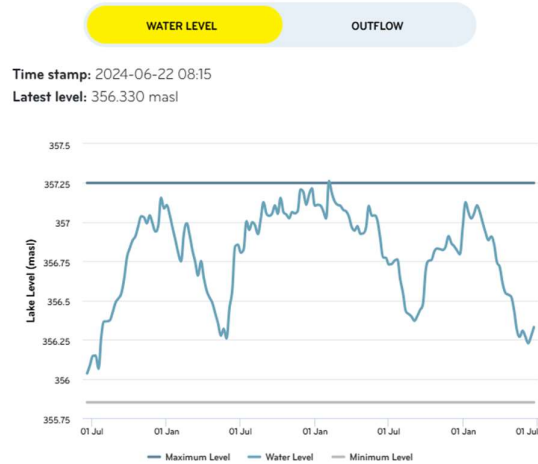


## Lake Levels

## **Annual Passes**

We will not be issuing stickers this year for Annual passes; the new Camera system has made the need for these obsolete. All current Annual passes will end on October 1st. We will send out reminders closer to the time you complete your purchase for the 2024-2025 season. The camera system has worked well over the past eight months, with nearly 100% compliance from day pass users.

## **Holiday Berth Rentals**

We will issue boat passes/ stickers for users renting berths this year. This will assist the team in identifying any boats that should not be in a berth. All Berth Holders will receive their stickers before Christmas, and it would be great if these could be displayed prominently on the left-hand side of the boat for easy identification over the busy season.

Taupo District Council have appointed a contractor to repair the bridge, and we understand that this work will commence in late August.
